



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

FOR

TAIWAN EDUCATION CENTER

BETWEEN

NATIONAL TSING HUA UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN

AND

JAYPEE INSTITUTE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, NOIDA, INDIA

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) takes effect on 08/08/2024, with National Tsing Hua University (NTHU) and Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida having entered into the agreement to cooperate in Taiwan Education Center.

The terms of this Agreement consist of the following:

- A. NTHU will facilitate JIIT in disseminating knowledge about Mandarin Chinese Language, promoting Taiwan's culture, and higher education.
- B. NTHU will offer Mandarin Chinese as foreign language courses to students of JIIT. The instructor recruited and trained by NTHU shall have expertise in designing the teaching curriculum and assessing students' Mandarin Chinese skills and levels.

The instructor shall be responsible for teaching Mandarin Chinese language courses over a period of two semesters for general purposes.

- C. JIIT shall provide designated separate office and classroom space for Taiwan Education Center at JIIT Branch (TEC-JIIT) to conduct classes, seminars, cultural events etc. TEC-JIIT can use the designated space to conduct additional Mandarin Chinese classes with the permission of JIIT.

NTHU will send instructors to the campus of JIIT and help establish the pedagogical and methodological bases for the Mandarin Chinese language courses. NTHU may also send an intern teacher to facilitate the Mandarin Chinese teaching in JIIT.

The instructor shall meet the following requirements:

1. Bachelor's, Master's or Ph.D. Degree in Humanities or related fields. In case the candidate has a Ph.D. degree, he or she can be appointed as a visiting faculty if other requirements of JIIT in this regard are met.
2. Knowledge of English as medium of instruction.

D. Services and Cost:

NTHU: NTHU will recruit and train Mandarin Chinese instructors for JIIT.

JIIT: JIIT will provide the following benefits to the instructors:

1. INR 50,000 – 70,000 net monthly salary (after taxes and deductions, if any)
2. Airfare (economy class) of one round trip between Taiwan and India once a year.
3. Assistance on acquiring employment visa and immigration-related issues.



4. Fully furnished accommodation near the campus and academic facilities as provided to visiting faculty at no cost. (Refer to Appendix A for List of Furniture and Utilities)
 5. Free use of the medical facilities including doctor visit and medicine on campus at no cost.
 6. The instructor can also purchase the same medical insurance offered to JIIT employees at the same rate. This means that along with the use of medical facilities and medicines at JIIT. The instructor will have medical insurance to have treatment outside of JIIT as well, in case of an emergency.
- E. The instructor is expected to fulfill the following responsibilities at TEC-JIIT with other responsibilities as follows,
1. Teach Mandarin Chinese courses in JIIT (no more than 12 hours per week).
 2. Promote Mandarin Chinese learning and introduce Chinese culture on-campus and off-campus.
 3. Improve bilateral collaboration between India/JIIT and Taiwan/NTHU.
- F. Duration and Amendment of Agreement
- This Memorandum of Understanding is effective from the date when representatives of the two institutions affix their signatures, and is valid for five (5) years. This Memorandum of Understanding, with the written consent of both institutions, may be amended, extended or terminated, with a six (6) months' period of notice, by either institution. This Memorandum of Understanding is renewed automatically as long as neither institution gives notice of termination to the other six (6) months prior to the end of the five (5) year term. In case of termination, the commitments made to staff or students already participating in the programs of JIIT not be affected.
- G. Equal Opportunity
- Both parties subscribe to the policy of Equal Opportunity and will not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, sexual orientation, age, religion or national origin. Both parties shall abide by these principles in the administration of this Agreement and neither party shall impose criteria by the exchange of students which would violate the principles of non-discrimination.
